## Sisters of the Dance

### September 22, 23, 24, 25 2011

We invite *women* to dance, sing and pray together at the Autumn Equinox for a weekend of ceremony, celebration and healing under the stars. We invite all dancers to come on Thursday to help prepare the land. We will gather in Arroyo Grande for three days beginning at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, Sept. 21 until 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, Sept. 24 at which time the gates will close. Our Orientation circle starts at 11:00 a.m. **Opening Ceremony** is at sunset.

Women of all ages, from young women who have begun their moon time to Grandmother Elders, will be dancing all night long to dance our sacred dream awake and to honor our Mother Earth. A traditional **Women's Sweat Lodge** will be open to all dancers on Saturday night during ceremony.

For the women who are in their moon time, we will also offer a special teaching **Moon Lodge** to honor their sacred time and create power rituals to reclaim moon power.

The **Mother Lodge** welcomes all women in support of the process of being a mother/daughter.

We will have a **Grandmother Lodge** to honor our Elders. We promise to offer them a comfortable place to experience the Long Dance as they grace us with their presence and wisdom.

A **Drum Circle** will share the responsibility of maintaining the constant drumbeat from sunset to sunrise. **All are invited to drum!**

Bring a **Potluck** supper for **Thursday** and **Friday evening** and **your own food for the day Thursday, Friday and Saturday**. A catered **Harvest Breakfast feast** is planned for Sunday morning after our glorious night of dancing. Hot teas and coffee will be available at all times throughout the night.

A special feature of the dance will be the **Giveaway Round** on Sunday morning during the Harvest Feast. Bring a gift, either simple or lavish, for a dance sister to choose anonymously from the Giveaway Blanket. It could be something you've made, or purchased, or had for years and wish to pass along, something you've created, something heart-felt and beautiful to honor the Sisterhood of the Dance.

When Saturday's Orientation Circle is completed, a **Trade Circle** will be open to **all** women who wish to display their arts, crafts or services for sale or barter. This promises us an opportunity to celebrate and support our creativity and skills as well as giving us a time for fundraising.

### **BROTHERS**

Men are invited to support this ceremony by joining the **Thunder Lodge**. This lodge provides physical support and protection, energetic as well as physical for this ceremony. They have their own ceremonial circle in their camp and a Sweatlodge Ceremony Thursday night!

This is a physically challenging ceremony. It is a participatory "LONG" Dance. It's about submerging one self in a timeless void of intense energy and exposure to Air, Fire, Water, Earth, and Spirit. Attending this ceremony is being present and actively engaged with the aspects of this Living Prayer. It is you who makes this Ceremony; join us in creating a shapeshifting experience.

## What to bring:

- ⇒ **Comfortable**, layered clothing plus a special dance dress or (skirt which is required for the dance).
- ⇒ Masks face painting, musical instruments, drums, rattles, songs, stories.
- ⇒ Blanket for warmth.
- ⇒ Towel for the Sweat Lodge. **No contact lenses allowed in Sweat.**
- ⇒ Water, food & beverages, reusable utensils, cup & plate. **These are not provided.**
- ⇒ We suggest 5 gallons of water, per person. We also recommend freezing one gallon.
- ⇒ Sunscreen and hat.
- ⇒ For Thursday, Friday, and Saturday, bring food and drink.
- ⇒ A potluck offering for Thursday and Friday evening meals.
- ⇒ A gift for the Giveaway Blanket on Sunday.
- ⇒ Art, crafts, or services to sell or barter at the Trade Circle.
- ⇒ A donation of wood to feed the sacred fires.
- ⇒ A donation of a good, used, dark-colored blanket (moving quilts are welcomed) for Sweat Lodge or charity.
- ⇒ All participants may choose to arrive on Thursday morning to prepare the land. Bring camping gear for Thursday and Friday ONLY.
- ⇒ **Campsites will be packed up and put away by the start of ceremony (sunset) Saturday.**
- ⇒ Please, NO children or pets at the dance. Leave them safe with family and friends.
- ⇒ **Brothers** come prepared with plenty food and water. Camping gear, flashlight, layered warm clothes. A stove will be provided for your cooking needs. Your Sweat Lodge ceremony will be Thursday late afternoon, with a potluck after.

**Please remember what you bring in,  
Including trash and recycling, you take out!**

***We invite circles from all traditions or solitaires to this all-way ceremony. We honor the many traditions of the four directions. We welcome the possibility of a earth based powerful dynamic expression of shape shifting collective energy. Participants bring their unique medicine to the whole. We welcome All Our Relations, to the highest good of all.***

We hope that you will join in on our preparation! Everyone is welcome in the Home Lodge and in the building of the village. The Core Circle is, however, reserved for those who have actively participated in the Home Lodge for at **least the last two years**.

As we build the village, we gain a three dimensional experience of the medicines of the five directions. Choosing to walk through participation in the building of a village leads us to a deeper connection to the elements and mysteries at play in our lives. We are blessed with the opportunity to experience true community with a group of individuals committed to spiritual expression through ceremony. Come laugh and play as we raise our sacred village.

**LONG DANCE CEREMONY: SEPTEMBER 22-25, 2011**

*Defining a Chief:* A leader who serves the people, not a ruler or governor. Power comes with responsibility and a Chief is accountable to the people. They do not determine who comes to ceremony they serve to the greater good.

*Defining a Dog Soldier:*

The medicine of Dog is the medicine of loyalty – to oneself, to a group, to a ceremony, or a cause. The Dog soldier shows up with integrity, with everything that they are. They give from the heart, requiring nothing in return. The Dog Soldier role is a place of learning through doing. By becoming one who uses their energy and resources wisely, they are able to contribute freely to the whole without being drained or lessened. The Dog Soldier is not a position of glamour, of constant praise and recognition. It is a position of honor – where word is backed up by action, and where an individual can demonstrate their impeccability.

RELEASE

- 3. As consideration for being permitted by COMPANY or one of its affiliated organizations to participate in the USE of PROPERITY, I hereby agree that I, my assignees, heirs, distributees, guardians and legal representatives will not make a claim against, sue, or attach the PROPERITY of COMPANY or any of its affiliated organizations for injury, death, destruction or damage resulting from the negligence , active, passive, or other wise, howsoever caused, by any employee, agent, or contractor of COMPANY or any of its affiliated organizations as a result of my participation in the USE of PROPERITY.
